As you may know, the Stockton City Council recently voted to ban new superstores from the City of Stockton. While we were disappointed with this decision, we have heard what the City said. We are pleased to announce plans for a new store at the corner of Highway 5 and French Camp Road that will meet the criteria the city desires. The smaller, unique store will be a part of the proposed Weston Ranch Towne Center.

It is well known throughout the region that South Stockton, and specifically the Weston Ranch community, is grossly underserved. Wal-Mart is committed to serving its customers in this area, and looks forward to working with the City of Stockton to build a store that Weston Ranch can be proud of.

Meet Your Neighbor

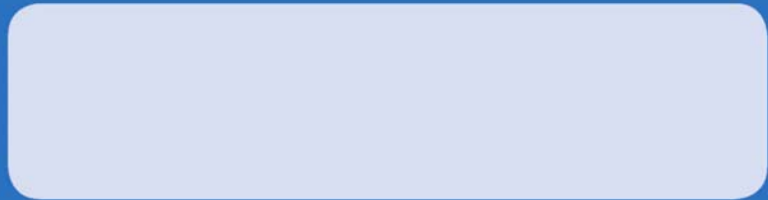
